### **“CREATION CARE CORNER”:**

Palm oil is in everything from cookies to cosmetics to detergents. It is an edible vegetable oil derived from pulping the fruit of oil palm trees, originally native to Africa; but, now also found in Indonesia and Malaysia. The food industry is using palm oil in its products because of its affordable price and it does not contain trans fat. The popularity of palm oil is due to us consumers who buy the products made with it.

“Conventional palm oil” is produced in ways that destroy our tropical forests and peat lands, adding to global warming emissions and reducing the habitat of many threatened species. Tropical forests are being decimated so palm oil plantations can be established. And besides the environmental destruction, a hidden cost is the exploitation of countless workers in southeast Asia.

Palm oil concoctions appear under different names; such as sodium dodecyl sulfate, lactylate, glyceryl stearate, to name a few. With the abundance of derivatives in the market, it is now believed that boycotting the products would not be as effective as contacting the companies.

A plus is that palm oil can be produced without deforestation! Many companies, like Dunkin Brands and Colgate-Palmolive, have begun to purchase what is called Eco-friendly palm oil.

The action, then, that we as consumers can take is to write the manufacturers with our concerns about palm oil and demand that it be responsibly sourced. Some major users of “conventional palm oil” include Campbell's, Heinz, Hormel, and PepsiCo.
